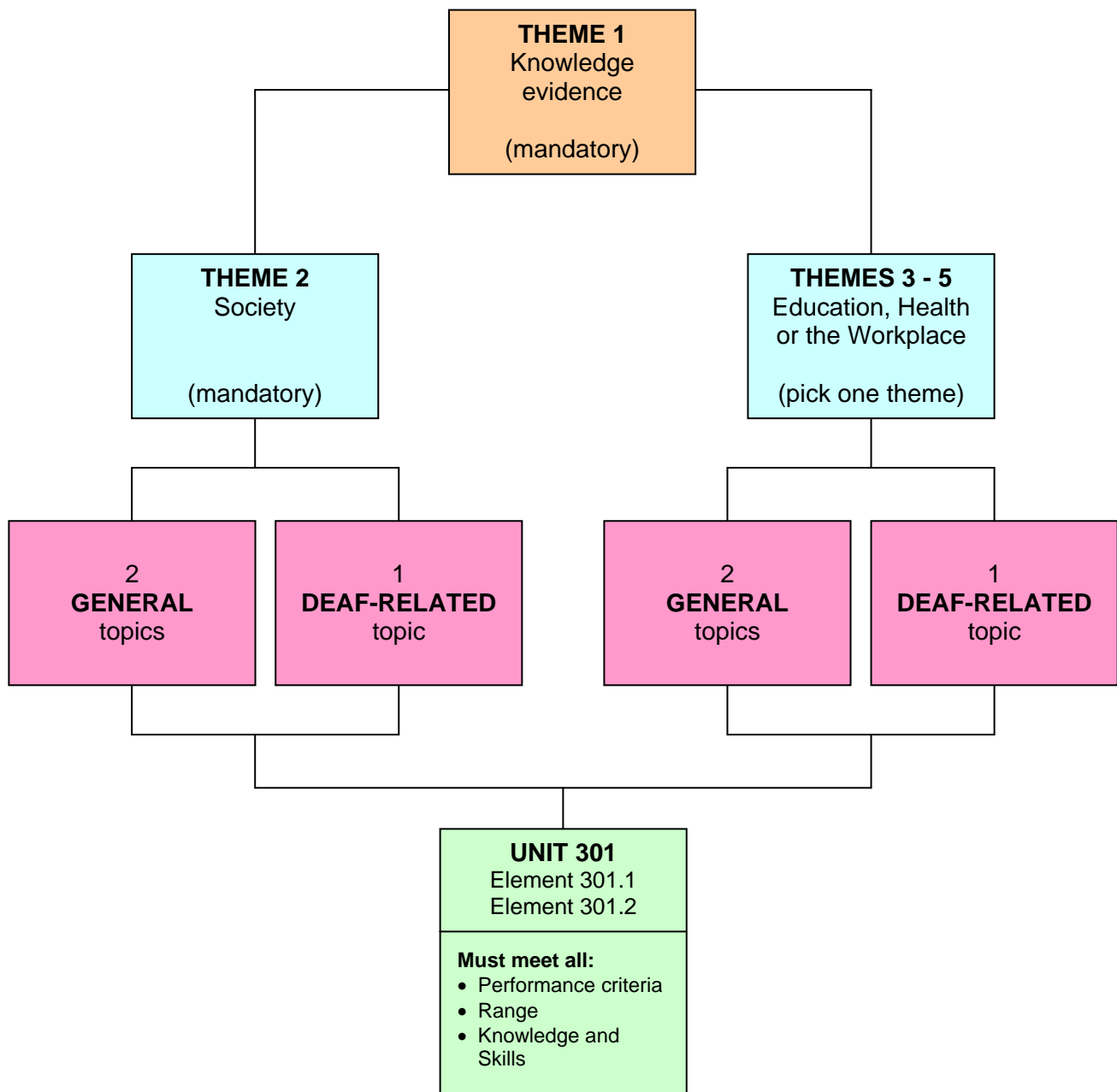


LEVEL 3 CERTIFICATE IN BSL/ISL QUALIFICATION SPECIFICATION

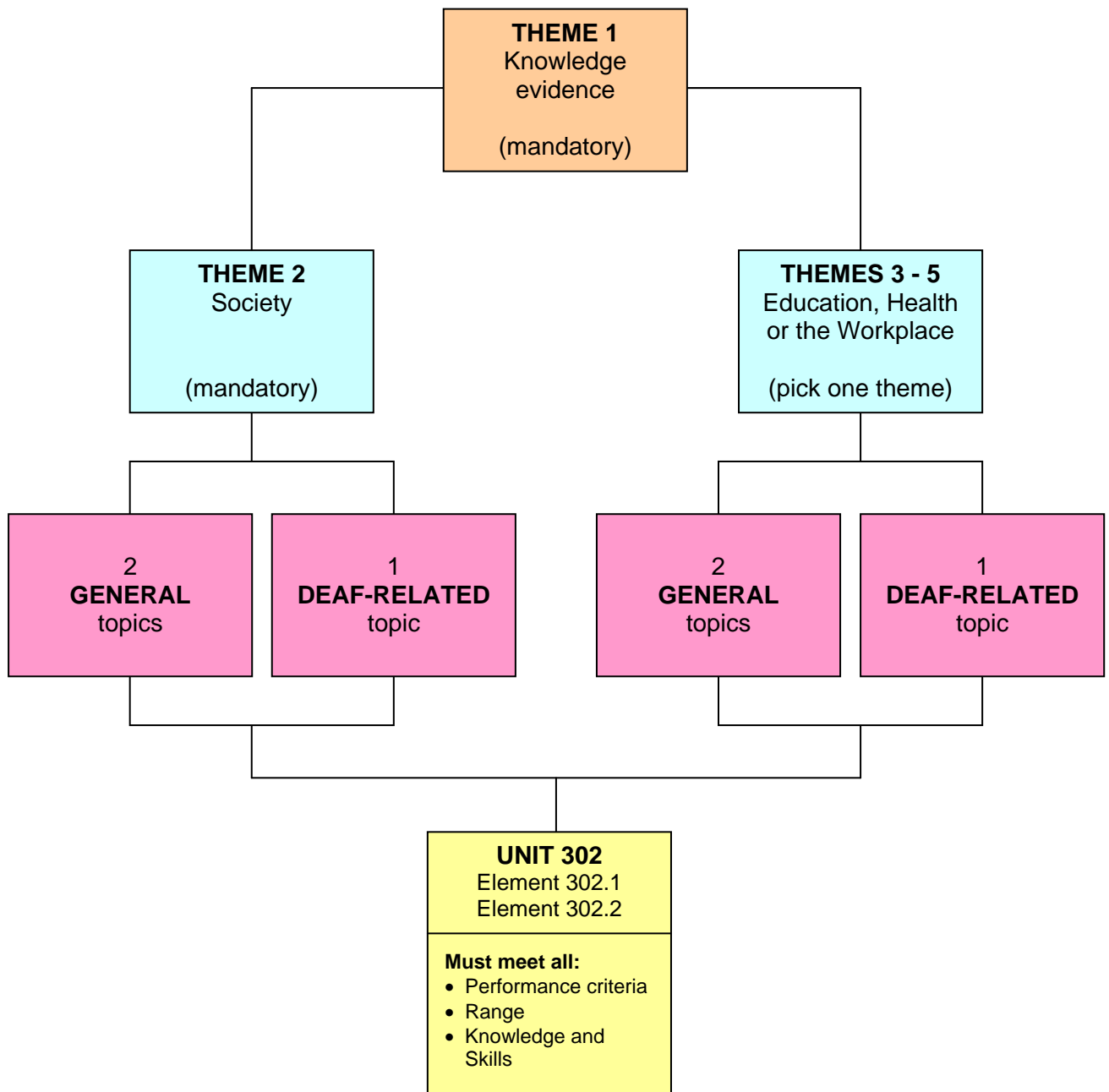
CACDP would like to draw centres attention to page 4 of the above qualification specification, which should assist your work with the candidates. The diagram shows in detail what will be expected in each unit 301 and unit 302 in collecting evidence for their portfolios.

It is no longer necessary to photocopy everyone's CAR to send to CACDP because the moderator will either visit the centre or do a desktop moderation in the future and will inspect the CARs in the candidate's portfolios themselves.



The whole Portfolio must consist the following:-

- Assessment plans showing progress and review
- CAR form should show 6 different topics accepted by teacher-assessor
- Performance Criteria in both elements may be covered more than once
- Knowledge and Skills may be covered more than once
- Range may be covered more than once
- Must have 5 evidences or more in the portfolio (it can be overlapped with Unit 302)
- To show range of vocabulary expected at Level 3
- All evidences must be clearly referenced across the portfolio
- All papers has to be signed by candidate and teacher-assessor



The whole Portfolio must consist the following:-
