

Introduction to CACDP

CACDP is committed to promoting communication between deaf* and hearing people. We do this as an awarding body recognised by the Qualifications and Curriculum Authority (QCA), offering high quality nationally recognised qualifications in sign language and other forms of communication used by deaf people, and registration systems for Language Service Professionals. Courses leading to CACDP awards from Level 1 to Level 4 are provided at over 700 centres around the UK.

CACDP was established for this purpose in 1980 by national organisations of and for deaf people to ensure the availability of learning opportunities, qualifications and standards in the communication methods used by deaf people. These organisations are still closely involved with CACDP as trustees, project partners, advisers and as members of committees.

On 1 January 1982 CACDP became an independent organisation and charitable status was granted.

*We use the term "deaf people" to refer to those who are Deaf, deaf, deafened, hard of hearing and deafblind.
